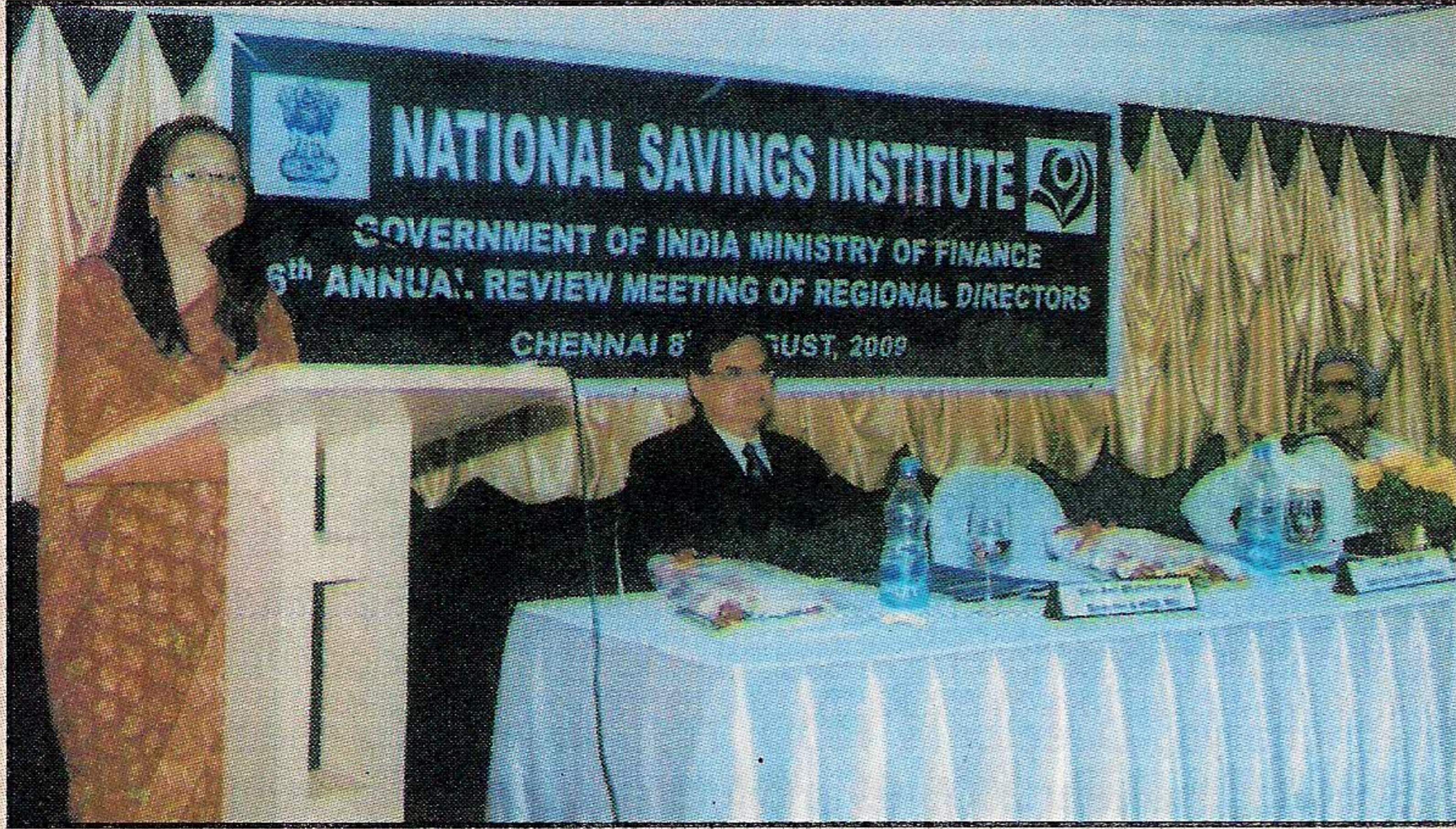

NSI Organises Annual Review Meeting of Regional Directors

NSI organized Annual Review Meeting of Regional Directors, on 8th August, 2009 at Chennai. The objective was to review the performance of the Regions during the year 2008-09 and draw strategy for enhancing financial inclusions to enlarge the outreach of National Savings Products and discuss the marketing strategies for achieving the targets fixed by Ministry for the year 2009-10.

The ARM was inaugurated by Smt. L.M. Vas, I.A.S., Additional Secretary, Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India. During her inaugural address, she advised the officers to identify new segments in the society and bring them into the fold of savings movement. She congratulated the Director, NSI and his team for mobilizing Rs. 1,58,000 crores gross against the target of Rs. 1,50,000 crores during the year 2008-09 inspite of the volatile situation in the financial market.
