The topics range from savings bank transition from traditional to the Universal banking, Para banking services, housing policies, Retail Banking, Micro Finance and Financial Inclusions of unbanked people. WSBI also facilitates international cooperation among the member countries.

NSI is the oldest member of WSBI and has developed an expertise during last 50 years in the field of savings mobilisation. During the recent years NSI has organised number of workshops / training programmes for the developing countries i.e. Workshop on 'Micro Finance & Micro Lending' for Senior Executives of Savings Bank, Mongolia at Nagpur, a training programme for Senior Executives of Vietnam Postal Savings Bank on 'Marketing & Savings mobilisation' at Hanoi Vietnam and a workshop on 'Access to Finance' at New Delhi.
